The enterprise is engaged in purchasing and processing milk and selling dairy products in the country and abroad. The product range consists of various kinds of dairy products and pasteurised milk. The grant will be utilised to procure butter-making equipment in order to increase production and improve the quality of products. This will lead to the creation of two new jobs immediately and three in the long term. The enterprise will be conducting corporate social responsibility activities which include the delivery of dairy products to socially vulnerable citizens.

Server and network equipment were procured through the project, as well as necessary licences. The aim of this activity was to contribute to the creation of a more favourable business environment by improving the efficiency and transparency of the e-government and, ultimately, to new investments. At the same time, citizens' trust in institutions, as well as the quality of services that are being offered through the e-government will also be enhanced.
