The activity is focused on enhancing conditions for construction or reconstruction of facilities of economic infrastructure through the development of technical documentation – execution designs.

BELA PALANKA	<b>Development of Execution design for the reconstruction of the facilities of the former factory "Femid" in Bela Palanka</b>	EU PRO <b>EUR 18,630</b> Local self-government <b>EUR 2,070</b>	The development of technical documentation for the reconstruction of facilities of the former factory "Femid", including the production hall (1848 m <sup>2</sup> ), reception area (185 m <sup>2</sup> ) and warehouse (465 m <sup>2</sup> ), should facilitate investments in economic infrastructure thus contributing to creation of conducive business environment for existing and future investors and ultimately result in the improved living standards of the local population.
2.	ČAČAK	<b>Development of Technical Documentation for the Science and Technology Park in Čačak</b>	EU PRO <b>EUR 30,000</b> Local self-government <b>EUR 19,900</b>	The development of technical documentation for the new Science and Technology Park in Čačak will create technical conditions for the facility construction to be funded by the Government of Serbia. The facility will provide space adequate for the functioning of IT companies and related academic and business associations, whilst boosting the capacity for innovation and developing partnerships between all stakeholders.

DOLJEVAC	<b>Execution of the Design for the Construction of Primary Water Supply for the Working-Business zone in Malošište</b>	EU PRO <b>EUR 19,190</b> Local self-government <b>EUR 2,520</b>	The development of technical documentation for the construction of primary water supply will enable further development of businesses in the Working-Business Zone in Malošište and contribute to an increase in the standard and quality of living of the local population.
4.	KNJAŽEVAC	<b>Development of Execution Design for the Training/ Start-up Centre in Rgošte village</b>	EU PRO <b>EUR 6,050</b> Local self-government <b>EUR 750</b>	Developing technical documentation for the reconstruction of a building of Rgošte village school, Knjaževac municipality, will create conditions for setting up a Training/Start-up centre for the food-processing industry, which will enable the acquisition of the knowledge and skills necessary for dealing with fruit and vegetable processing.
5.	KRAGUJEVAC	<b>Execution Design for the Rehabilitation of the Bridge over the Lepenica River</b>	EU PRO <b>EUR 30,000</b> Local self-government <b>EUR 8,116</b>	Developing technical documentation for the rehabilitation of the bridge over the Lepenica River will create the conditions necessary for reconstruction works. This will ultimately provide safer transport conditions for existing and potential investors, users of the Kragujevac Business Zone, and their suppliers. The project will help facilitate industry investments primarily in the automotive domain.
6.	KRALJEVO	<b>Development of technical documentation for the drainage project in the Industrial Zone Šeovac</b>	EU PRO <b>EUR 24,600</b> Local self-government <b>EUR 3,370</b>	The development of technical documentation will create conditions enabling the construction of drainage system to prevent further damage caused by flooding in the Industrial Zone Šeovac. It will also provide support in the realisation of investments of both new foreign investors and local entrepreneurs, already working in this industrial zone.
7.	KUČEVO	<b>Development of Technical Documentation for the Business Incubator Centre</b>	EU PRO <b>EUR 20,466</b> Local self-government <b>EUR 3,330</b>	The development of the technical documentation will create conditions for the adaptation of the Business Incubator centre in Kučevo which, once adapted, will provide opportunities for the unemployed to get acquainted with regulations and the possibility of starting their own business. It would also create the possibility for the existing business entities to exchange knowledge and experience how to attract more incentive funds, expand their activity and employ new workers.

NIŠ	<b>Development of the Execution Design for a Multifunctional Expo Centre</b>	EU PRO <b>EUR 30,000</b> Local self-government <b>EUR 40,635</b>	The development of technical documentation, including urban design, will enable the construction of a Multifunctional Expo Centre which, once constructed, should increase the capacity of the City of Niš in the domain of tourism economy, particularly, event and congress tourism, sports events, etc.

SMEDEREVO	<b>Development of Execution Design for a Main Pipeline for Water-supply for the Industrial zone in Smederevo</b>	EU PRO <b>EUR 23,454</b> Local self-government <b>EUR 2,606</b>	The development of technical documentation for a water supply system in the Smederevo Industrial Zone will enable its construction and thus meet the key preconditions (including proper water-supply and sanitary and fire protection conditions) that are necessary for attracting new investors and the development of businesses already operating in the zone.
10.	TOPOLA	<b>Development of Execution Design for a Distributive Irrigation Network</b>	EU PRO <b>EUR 30,000</b> Local self-government <b>EUR 18,194</b>	The development of technical documentation for the phase II irrigation distribution system, which covers 300 ha, when constructed, will bring water to 80 producers in the villages of Vinča and Plaskovac. It should also create conditions for an increase in agricultural production and sales, since the irrigation system will ensure continuous quantity and quality of produce to small family owned fruit-growing enterprises from the municipality, which will be able to increase their market share at domestic and foreign markets and create new jobs.

VLADIČIN HAN	<b>Development of Execution Design for the Infrastructural Equipping of the Industrial Zone</b>	EU PRO <b>EUR 12,305</b> Local self-government <b>EUR 1,400</b>	The technical documentation developed for the utility infrastructure in the industrial zone in Vladičin Han will regulate the conditions for construction and enable the local administration to offer plots to new potential investors, thus creating new job opportunities for its inhabitants.

VRANJE	<b>Development of Technical Documentation for Reconstruction of Multimedia - Business Centre</b>	EU PRO <b>EUR 30,000</b> Local self-government <b>EUR 28,000</b>	The development of technical documentation for the Multimedia-Business Centre will create conditions for its reconstruction which, once finalised, will provide support to businesses, promotion of the investment potential of Vranje and the region and substantially contribute to the development of tourism, especially congress and cultural tourism.
