The beneficiary of the funds is responsible for the implementation of the project, while UNOPS monitors the implementation and provides technical support.

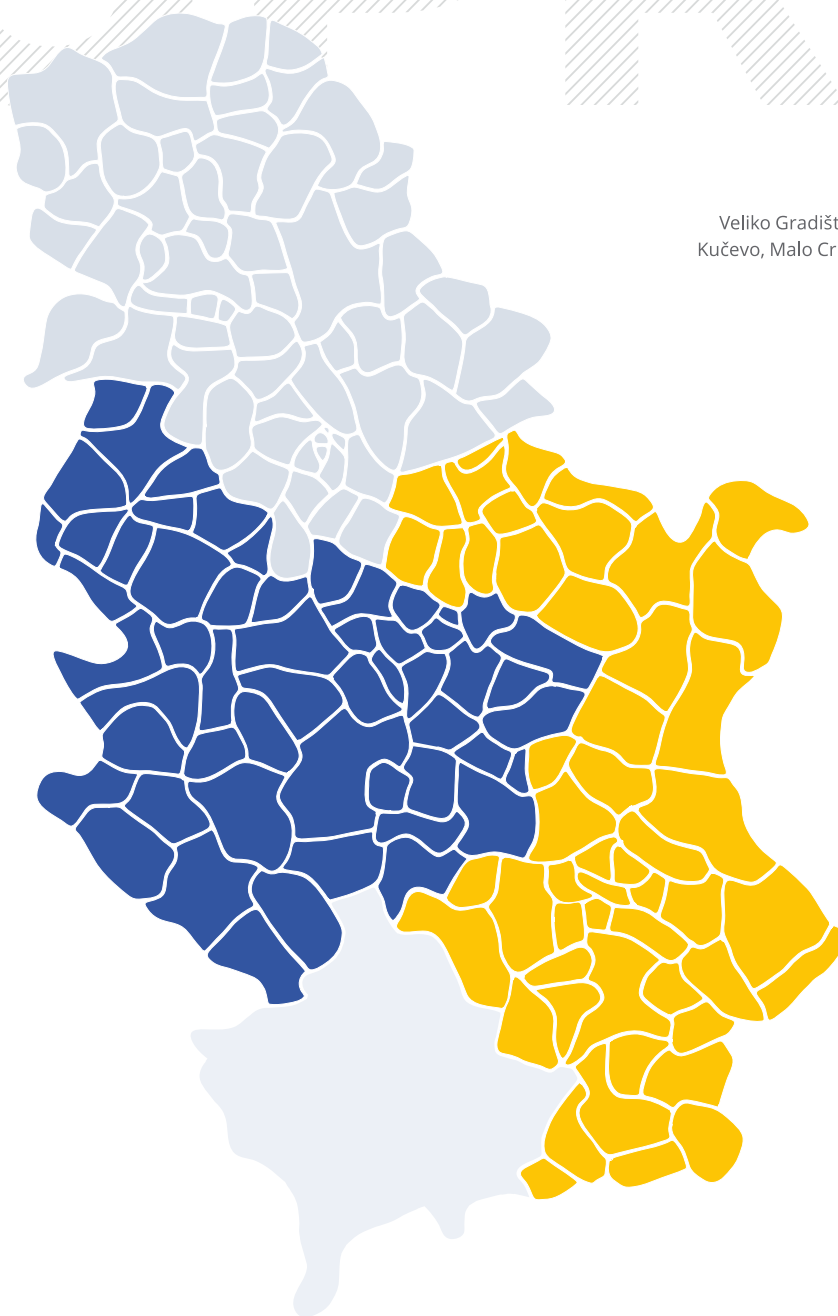
